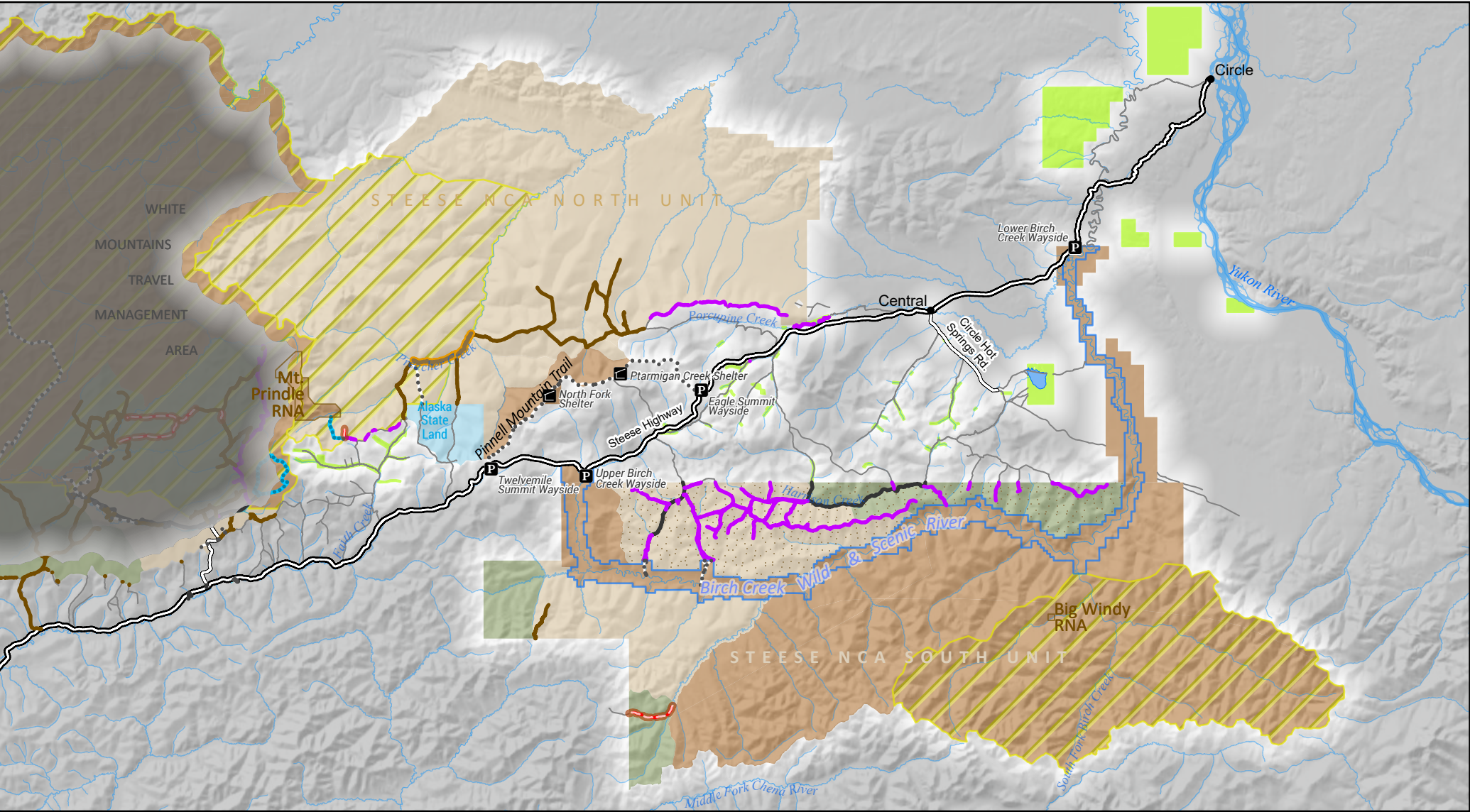

TMZ 1 & 5(RNA): No Summer Use of OHVs

TMZ 2: No OHV Cross Country Travel Allowed. All OHVs are limited to designated routes, if present.

TMZ 3: Cross country travel allowed for OHVs 1,000 lbs or less curb weight and a maximum width of 50 inches.

TMZ 4: Cross country travel allowed for OHVs 1,500 lbs or less curb weight and a maximum width of 64 inches.

No Domestic Sheep, Goats, or Camelids Allowed.

Off-route game retrieval as defined in the TMP is allowed using up to 3 OHVs up to 1,000 lbs curb weight, OR 1 OHV up to 1,500 lbs curb weight.
