Dear Reader:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Rock Springs and Rawlins Field Offices are launching a 30-day public review for Environmental Assessment (EA) *BLM-WY-D040-2020-0005-EA*, a proposed wild horse gather in the Adobe Town, Salt Wells Creek, Great Divide Basin, White Mountain and Little Colorado Herd Management Areas (HMAs).

The BLM proposes to gather and remove 3,555 excess wild horses to the low end of the Appropriate Management Level (AML) on these 5 HMAs. Non-permanent fertility control treatments would also be implemented across the HMAs. The BLM also analyzed a no action alternative and additional action alternatives that include a variety of other fertility control methods.
