The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) received Expressions of Interest to sell Federal oil and gas leases on 11 parcels of Federal minerals within the North Dakota Field Office, Miles City Field Office, and Dakota Prairie Grasslands (USFS) areas in a future lease sale. All information regarding the lease sale, including the Environmental Assessment, Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and all corresponding appendices, maps, and map data are available on the BLM's ePlanning website link below.

Public Involvement Opportunity

A 30-day comment period will be available starting on November 19, 2024, and ending December 20, 2024. Electronic comment submission is available; written comments must be postmarked by December 20, 2024, to be considered. Comments should be within the scope of the proposed action, specific to the proposed action, have a direct relationship to the proposed action and include supporting reasons for the BLM to consider. Issues identified from public comment may be used to modify or add project design features, mitigation, or alternatives.
