**DECISION RECORD  
For Amendment Libra Solar  
DOI-BLM-NV-C010-2026-0002-DNA**

**I. DECISION**

The BLM will authorize the amended Libra Solar Project, which includes realignments to the gen-tie line, expanded pull and tension sites, closure and rerouting of State Route 2C, updated solar block layout, and revised stormwater management. These modifications are within the scope of the 2024 FEIS and ROD.

**A. Mitigation Measures**

All mitigation measures identified in the 2024 FEIS remain applicable to the amended Libra Solar Project.

**B. Monitoring**

BLM staff will monitor construction activities to ensure compliance with the approved right-of-way (ROW) stipulations and environmental protection measures.

**II. COMPLIANCE AND CONFORMANCE**

The Proposed Action is in conformance with FLPMA of 1976, the CRMP adopted in 2001, the regulations at 43 CFR §4100, and with current BLM policies, plans, and programs. The Proposed Action is consistent in relationship to statutes, regulations, and policies of neighboring local, County, State, Tribal governments, and other Federal agencies.

**III. RATIONALE FOR DECISION**

I have determined that the existing National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document identified below adequately analyzes and discloses the potential effects associated with the Proposed Action described in DOI-BLM-NV-C010-2026-0002-DNA, and that the Proposed Action is in conformance with the Carson City Field Office Consolidated Resource Management Plan (CRMP).

The applicant seeks authorization for conducting realignments to the gen-tie line, expanded pull and tension sites, closure and rerouting of State Route 2C, updated solar block layout, and revised stormwater management. BLM lands to support the final design of the Libra Solar Project located 11 miles southeast of the town of Yerington, Nevada.

Disturbance will occur within the analysis area addressed in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Libra Solar Project.

#### **IV. RIGHT OF PROTEST AND/OR APPEAL:**

This decision may be appealed to the Interior Board of Land Appeals (IBLA), Office of Hearings and Appeals, in accordance with the regulations contained in 43 CFR Part 4. The notice of appeal must be filed no later than 30 days after the date of receiving notice of this decision. Any notice of appeal must be filed with the IBLA and must include a copy of the decision being appealed, a statement of standing, and a statement of timeliness.

If you wish to file a petition for a stay of the effectiveness of this decision during the time that your appeal is being reviewed by the Board, the petition for a stay must show sufficient justification based on the following criteria at 43 CFR 4.405(b).

The appellant must serve a copy of the notice of appeal and any accompanying documents on the office of the officer who made the decision, each person or entity named in the decision, and the appropriate Office of the Solicitor at the time of filing with IBLA (see 43 CFR 4.403(b); 4.407(b)). Parties must serve the Office of the Solicitor at the address shown on Form 1842-1. Service on a party known to be represented by an attorney or other designated representative must be made on the representative. If a statement of reasons for the appeal is not included with the notice of appeal, it must be filed within 30 days after the record on appeal is filed with the IBLA. Failure to file a statement of reasons within the time required will subject the challenged decision to summary affirmance (see 43 CFR 4.412(a)).
