Description: The City of Bettles proposes to reroute two sections of the originally authorized right-of-way for the Bettles Winter Road within Secs. 19, 20, 21, 28, 29 and 30, T. 23 N., R. 15 W., and Sec. 25, T. 23 N., R. 16 W., Fairbanks Meridian containing approximately 12.46 acres. The first portion of the right-of-way described as Gordon's Gulch has already been rerouted without authorization and is now upland of the originally authorized road. The second portion of the right-of-way encompassing approximately two (2) miles is located in Secs. 29 and 30, T. 23 N., R. 15 W., and Sec. 25, T. 23 N., R. 16 W., Fairbanks Meridian. Two routes have been identified on the map that will be attached to the right-of-way grant. The decision as to which route to clear would be made by the City of Bettles. As soon as the grant is amended the City would use a contractor to clear the new route the majority of which would be 25' wide with three (3) areas (250') cleared to 50' wide as authorized in the original grant. Therefore all the clearing would be completed during the winter. The new route is depicted on the maps. Approximately 90% of the area burned in a 2013 wildfire and small snags (up to 4 inches in diameter) remain along the new route. The contractor would use a bulldozer or hydro-ax to clear the new route. The new route has been mapped and surveyed by the mayor of Bettles, Gary Hanchett, Darrin McLeod and Bill Hedman of BLM to ensure the grade is passable by fuel tankers and personal vehicles. This reroute is necessary due to landslides along the existing authorized winter road.
